

10 Policy Recommendations

for Inclusive Education of students with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities

Recommendation 1: Develop a comprehensive study program with a focus on inclusiveness.

This will provide clear guidelines and practical tools to support education and ensure that all educational policies and programs align with the principles of inclusive education.

Recommendation 2: Improve communication of inclusive education policies.

The educational community, parents, and society should be informed of inclusive education policies to raise awareness and promote a more inclusive culture in schools.

Recommendation 3: Offer targeted training for teachers

Assess the training needs of teachers and create programs tailored to their needs, with a focus on inclusive policies and legal frameworks for school managers.

Recommendation 4: Make inclusive tools and methods easily accessible.

Existing tools and training materials in inclusive education should be easily accessible to educators, with stakeholders assisting in the distribution of such materials.

Recommendation 5: Encourage cooperation between all parties involved.

This includes cooperation between agencies, teachers, parents, and school management, as well as involving the entire school staff and external institutions supporting students with SEND.

Recommendation 6: Redistribute financial resources.

Pilot financial funding of schools and agencies to implement inclusive educational programs and take measures to increase the number of school staff with permanent contracts.

Recommendation 7: Map and identify students with disabilities.

Recording cases of students with disabilities will help to better understand their needs and provide appropriate support.

Recommendation 8: Monitor and evaluate learning outcomes.

Develop internal school improvement processes and regularly monitor the quality of inclusive practices in classrooms.

Recommendation 9: Provide support and training for subject teachers and non-teaching staff.

This will ensure that all teachers are equipped with the necessary skills and knowledge to support students with SEND.

Recommendation 10: Increase awareness and sensitivity among parents.

Training for parents of normally developing children will help to increase their sensitivity to the needs of students with SEND.
